IMPROVING WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (WSH) THROUGH INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY AT OS+H ASIA 2018

29 August2018 – Building on the momentum of Singapore's Vision Zero movement which is focused on preventing injuries and being healthy at the workplace, the region's leading exhibition on workplace safety and health OS+H ASIA 2018 opens today at Suntec Singapore with more than 200 exhibitors from 20 countries.

From safety clothing and shoes embedded with temperature sensors and biometric monitoring, gas detection systems, respirators with mobile apps, to ergonomic and posture wellness solutions, OS+H ASIA 2018 is the eventof choice for sourcing and procurement of products and technologies for workplace safety health (WSH) practitioners, human resource (HR) managers, law enforcement officers, to owners of small and medium-sized enterprises(SMEs) and industry professionals from around the region. Various international delegations from China, Mongolia and Indonesia, and local visiting groups from Republic of Singapore Navy, Singapore Police Coast Guard, as well as companies representing the pharmaceutical, building and construction, offshore marine, shipbuilding, waste management services, electrical and electronic sectors, will be attendingthe exhibition over the next three days.

Though awareness for workplace safety and health has increased in recent years, accident numbers continue to be a focal point. In the first half of this year, there were 20 workplace fatalities in sectors such as construction, manufacturing and commercial diving, while statistics from the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) indicate that 285 workers sustained major injuries and 294 occupational disease cases were confirmed during the same period. Slips, trips and falls from height,

machinery and vehicular incidents were top incident types in the first quarter of 2018^{1} .

Set against the backdrop ofincreasing awareness on workplace accidents, fatalities, and occupational diseases, OS+H ASIA 2018 presents seven focus areas which include: Work at Height, Fire Protection, Environmental Control, Crisis and Emergency Management, Workplace Ergonomics, Smart Technologies and Health at Work.

For the first time, the exhibition will also introduce the OSH Technology Showcase which highlights smart technology and innovative solutions from companies such asAvetics Global, Fujitsu, andMagicsoft Asia Systems. The showcase will offer insight into range of technology; from drones to monitor and improve safety in high-risk areas, to wearable sensors for multiple applications including detecting drowsiness in drivers.

The exhibition will also feature a series of diverse technical presentations, seminars and interactive product demonstrations. These activities are helmed by a multidisciplinary, international selection of WSH professionals and industry thought-leaders.

New challenges and opportunities have arisen from increasing workloads and a greater need for multitasking as a result of digitalisation, demographic changes in populations, and frequent calls by governments and industries to adjust workplace safety standards for more healthy work environments. Commenting on this Mr Gernot Ringling, Managing Director, Messe Düsseldorf Asia, said: "Improving workplace safety and workplace health is important because they reinforce each other.OS+H Asia comes inas a valuable resource for industries and OSH practitioners in the region to procure supplies, share holistic approaches and latest practices that can elevate current
